News from our VK Neighbours:

Australia's Centenary of Federation - A special event station Victor India 3 PMG (VI3PMG) is on air to celebrate the Centenary of Federation, the formation 100 years ago of the Commonwealth of Australia. The special callsign was first used on May 9, the anniversary of the first sitting of the Commonwealth Parliament in 1901. An historical re-enactment took place on May 9, 2001, in the Royal Exhibition Building in Melbourne, the same venue for the first parliament 100 years ago.

The Wireless Institute of Australia is activating VI3PMG over the next 100 days to celebrate the Centenary of Federation, with a special emphasis on the communication milestones that have occurred in Australia over the past century. A special QSL card will be available. QSL toVK3WI or via the bureau.

ZL6A Activity on ANZAC Day:

Organiser Bob Pearce ZL2GJ and his team of nine volunteers activated ZL6A on Anzac Day and were active on 80, 40, 20, 15, 10m and VHF. Having a total of about 700 contacts. The question has been raised as to why no ZL6A operation on the UHF National System. Simply stated, when this ANZAC Day activity was introduced a few years ago, Council guidance was to avoid use of the National System. Some users like the increase in activity, others don't, and given the purpose and significance of the ANZAC operation controversy was certainly not wanted. More operational details of ZL6A's ANZAC activity will appear in the Awards Section of Break-In.
