QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY WEEKEND 1-2 JUNE 2002

Venue: Nelson Conference 2002 will be held at the Tahuna Beach Function Centre, located at the Tahuna beach Holiday Park, Beach Road, Tahuna Nelson. This is 6kms away from Nelson City center. Magnificent scenery, beach at your doorstep, central heating for your comfort, plenty of on site accommodation, parking and plenty of aerial space.

Provisional Programme: This programme will include the NZART AGM as well as the AGM'S of AREC, OTC, SPAM, WARO and AMSAT-ZL. Other talks and forums have been organised, a full and interesting programme will be available.

Guest Speaker: Dr Harry McQuillam ZL2SQ of Nelson will be our guest speaker at this year's Conference. Nelson's Mayor Mr. Paul Matheson will officially open the Conference.

Friday: The registration desk will be open at the Conference venue from 6pm until 10pm. Tea, coffee, and a bar will be available, so here is a good chance to have social get together.

Saturday: The registration desk will be open from 8.00am. The Conference will officially start at 9.00am, this will be followed by the AGM, lunch, guest speaker and forums, then to finish the day, the Annual Dinner.

Sunday: Sundays programme will include AGM'S for AREC, AMSAT-ZL, OTC, SPAM and WARO, plus various forums will be held during the day, ending with an evening meal and Sunday evening entertainment. All raffles will be drawn at this evening's function. Be prepared to have some fun and laughs tonight.

Alternative Programme: Saturday morning bus leaving venue 9.45am to take people into Nelson city to visit our famous flea market, shopping center, cathedral, or to just have some free time, returning to venue 12mid day for lunch. VHF/UHF/SHF Records with John Wysocki ZL2TWS: A 6m contact between Tim Moore ZL3VTV/1 and Jose EH7KW on 03/04/2001 over 19,921kms on SSB was confirmed by IARU Region–1 as a new ZL and World Record. This achievement by Tim ZL3VTV and EH7KW has broken the long standing 6m record held by ZL1MQ & ZB0T of 17/04/1981 over 18,250kms on SSB. Congratulations to Tim ZL3VTV for his record-breaking first QSO into Europe. ZL continues to hold many world DX records.
