The NZART Business Manager Debby ZL2TDM Says

SMART Callsign/Certificate Fees: Once again I reiterate with the introduction of the Certificate of Competency and Callsign allocation, NZART MUST recover some costs by imposing a fee structure.

The minimal time to process a new application for callsign and certificate is approximately 20 minutes, add postage and printing this soon adds to an already expensive exercise, however on the upside it will be done almost as soon as the application and relevant paper work is received here by me.

If I do not receive clearly completed applications and the Official Examination Result Notification, I am required to spend additional time and resources before I can complete the process. I ask ALL Examiners to please ensure that you forward all documentation to me as soon as possible.

The callsign/certificate fees to be charged by NZART as at 1 January 2007 are as follows:

Secondary Callsign application	\$10	

^{* [}members of NZART and those joining members who enclose at the time of forwarding the Radio 4A form an appropriate application form with fees, as set out in the Subscription Details below, are entitled to the Member's rate]

Present membership rates for those wishing to join NZART include:

Transmitting membership NZART \$95

Student Membership \$40 [special conditions apply]

Thus an intending full transmitting member would pay: Application for Callsign/Certificate of \$30 plus Membership fee of \$95 (total \$125) and an intending student member would pay Application for Callsign/Certificate of \$25 plus Membership fee of \$40 (total \$65).

Note:

- An amateur radio operator is required to hold a certificate and a callsign (NZ Radio Regulations, General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators 3 (1)).
- 2. These fees are subject to revision.

Important Notice to All Radio Amateurs, Students, Exam Candidates and Exam Supervisors

There have been regulatory and procedural changes involving the General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators, the General Amateur Operators Certificate of Competency, and to the Amateur Radio Callsign arrangements.

The new arrangements concern all radio amateurs. It is recommended that you download a copy of the *NEW RULES explained* booklet from the NZART website and study it - to be sure that you are familiar with our new operating circumstances.

The consequential detailed revisions of the Amateur Radio Examination Question-Bank and the many training documents have been completed.
