
Checking the RSM Database from Tony Case ZL1UD


This years Callbook has created a lot of flack that has been misdirected at NZART. The information contained in Callbook comes from the RSM register of public information. The only piece of information that you cannot hide from the public register is your name.

How to check the register:


Go to http://www.rsm.med.govt.nz/ you will get an error report. Click EXIT and this will place you on the following page:



Click on Search the Register




Click Search Certificates and Callsigns




- 1. Type in your callsign (e.g. 1UD) and
- 2. Click Search at the top of the page.


This will direct you to a list of callsigns (if you have a 2 letter call) or your own callsign (If you have a 3 letter call).



Click on the Client Number you wish to look up.



Click on Addresses and Contacts.



This will show you both your Billing / Postal, and Residential / Physical address. If you feel it necessary, both of these can be withheld. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to withhold these if you wish for them to be withheld, and IT IS ALSO YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to ensure that your request has been actioned. To change this information, phone 0800 RSMINFO or 0800 776-4636.

NZART cannot change any information that the MED give us for Callbook. It is your responsibility to ensure that the Public Information the MED Hold is correct; remember if you move or die, you are required by regulation to inform RSM within 7 days.

If you log on to SMART, the RSM database, you can withhold information online and print your own certificate. For this you will need your Client Key; Client Password and Client ID; these were sent you by RSM, and if they are lost, they can be replaced by phoning RSM.

Comments

This year's contest is unique in that it resulted in three perfect scores from three different Branches. As far as we can remember, this is the first time that there has been a three way tie for the Norm Edwards Shield and with perfect scores as well. Well done and congratulations to Murray Greenman, Chris Muir, and Mike McAlvey. Two entries were received for the John McKim cup, well done Mike Burch and Jim Lovell. Some contestants reported difficult conditions, especially those who were close to the centre of the country who were just out of range of the ground wave, and the sky wave would have been going straight over their heads. Reasonable reports were received from more distant stations. Once again Branch 65 Papakura receives the Branch Award. No results were received from some contestants who checked in after the contest.

For those who are interested, we use three frequency counters at the transmitting site. One counter is a high quality recently calibrated Agilent 53131A frequency counter. The other two universal counters are a Racal 9915 and a HP 5328A. All the meters are referenced against an Efratom Rubidium Frequency Oscillator which is what we use as our standard for the contest.

We both enjoy running the contest. It is a unique event in which both ourselves as well as the entrants have only one chance a year to get it right.
