## North Shore City Council Planning Hearing

Mike Newman ZL1BNB, NZART Local Government Liaison Officer, gave a verbal submission to the North Shore City Council Planning Hearing of 24 November 2006. Mike represented NZART.

The first three paragraphs are below to show you how much respect the NSCC has for amateur radio.

1. The proposed plan change was brought to the attention of the Association in May, when it was sent a copy of the agenda for a December 2005 Community Board meeting. Since the consultation period was well past, the Association made no contact with the Council at that time.

2. The proposed rules of Plan Change 18 are unacceptable to this Association, since they will cripple future installation of effective amateur radio operation, particularly high frequency (HF) operation in North Shore City.

3. No consultation was held with the amateur radio group. This was an inexplicable and most unfortunate oversight. Clearly the amateur radio antennas and supports were not an issue for the Council, otherwise those issues would have been known to those involved with the plan change preparation, who would then have been aware that there were issues over which consultation should take place...

# MESSAGE FROM NZ TEAM CAPTAIN, FRANK HUNT, ZL2BR REGARDING THIS WEEKEND'S COMMONWEALTH CONTEST(Edited)

Firstly thank you all for volunteering to be in the ZL team for this years Commonwealth (Beru) Contest.

In 2007 the algorithm used to calculate the "fiddle factor" that compensates for the disparity of activity available in the northern and southern hemispheres was 1.7. eg. the southern hemisphere team station scores were multiplied by 1.7. Transitional arrangements are in place for the first few years, until sufficient history has built up to provide a three year average. For 2008 this factor has reduced to 1.462.

As I see it our main rivals will be the "DX" team, which is mainly composed of Mediterranean and Caribibean stations, who will of course have easy propagation to G and VE stations.

Anyone not planning to operate for full 24 hours or planning to operate in the 12 hours categories, will of course probably find that the sunset to sunrise hours will be more productive that the daylight hours. The "Beru" has a reputation of being a relaxed, friendly, thinking-mans contest. So let all have fun, operate as seriously as we want to, but just serious enough so that we win the team contest eh!
