Update on the prohibition of unrestricted twoway radios

Our ALO Don Wallace, on behalf of NZART members has worked with RSM and they have come up with the release below. This is another example of the benefits of belonging to the association.

Update on the prohibition of unrestricted twoway radios

In August, we mentioned creating a prohibition notice for unrestricted two-way radios. This was to limit the availability to the general public for radios that don't meet the Radio Standards.

The prohibition notice is ready to gazette and will come into effect on 18 October 2018.

The notice will affect the supply of two-way radios like Baofeng, Pofung and Wouxun to the amateur market, but not equipment factory locked to the Amateur bands.

Amateur radio operators or suppliers need to hold a 'Licence to supply radio transmitters' to import and supply this equipment. When you've received your Licence to supply number, email us at supply@rsm.govt.nz. We'll add special conditions to your licence to allow the import and supply of this equipment. You'll need to supply us monthly returns of your imports and sales, including nil returns.

Election of President and the Executive Council To be held March 2019

Notice of appointment of Returning Officer

(Given in accordance with the Constitution of NZART)

I, Evan Sayer, inform Association members that the Council of NZART have appointed me to be the Returning Officer for the purposes of an election to be held for the office of President and for the Executive Council of NZART in March 2019.

Accordingly, I now issue the following Notice of Election.

Notice of Election

(Given in accordance with the Constitution of NZART)

I hereby call for nominations for the office of President and for the Executive Council of NZART

- 1. Nominations are to be addressed to the Returning Officer NZART Headquarters, PO Box 40 525, Upper Hutt 5140 and must be received by me by 31 December 2018
- 2. Every nomination shall be in writing and shall be signed by the person nominating and a seconder and shall be countersigned by the member nominated. The nomination should also contain a certificate signed by all three parties, that the candidate is an active amateur.
- 3. A member may be nominated for either or both the office of President and Councillor for a District.
- 4. In the election for Council **only** members attached to branches within the electoral district for which the election is being held are entitled to nominate or be nominated for office or vote in any election. To assist me in ensuring full compliance with this requirement, it is requested that the parties involved in any nomination for Council name their respective branches and state their common electoral district as being, either Northern, Central, Midlands or Southern (as the case may be).
- 5. It is desirable that Candidates provide me with personal biographical details, (which will be edited where necessary), for the inclusion with ballot papers to be posted out in February 2019.
