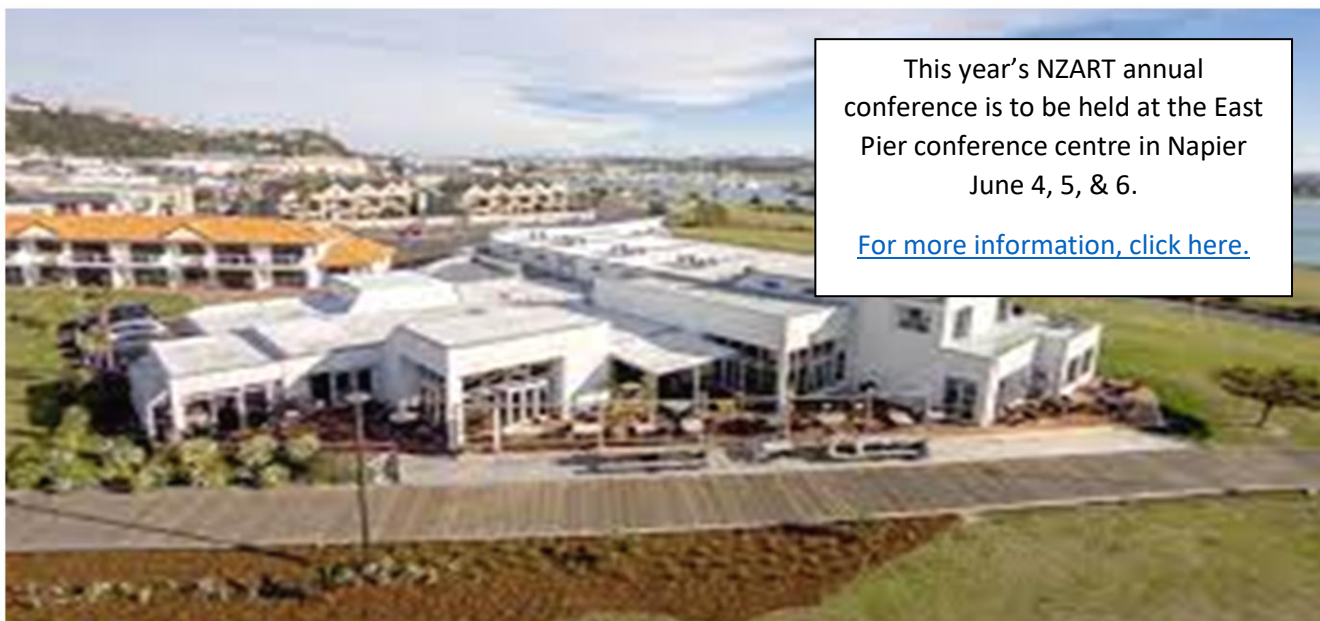
IARU R3 DM Coordinator role
