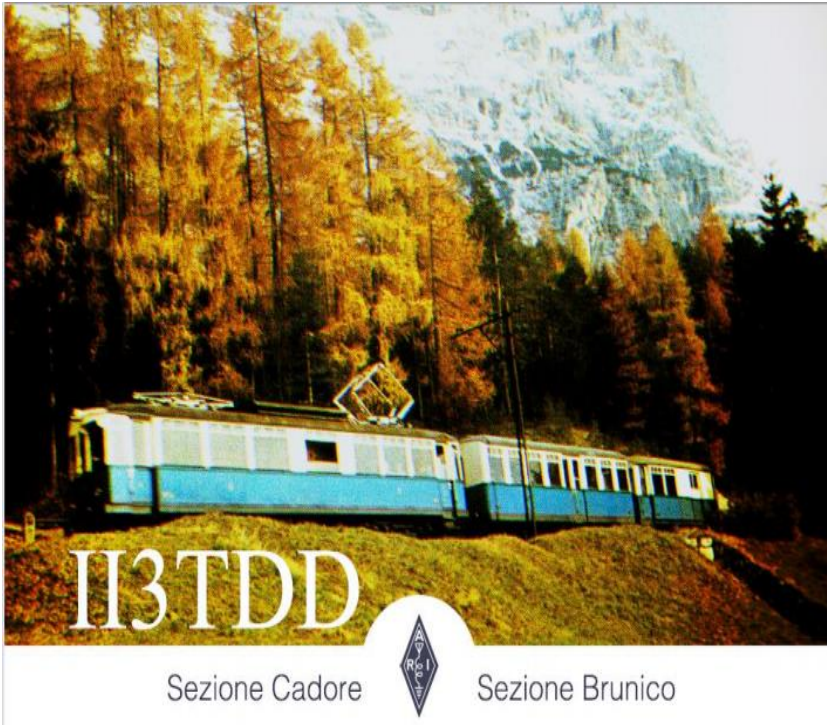
## AREC Regional Manager vacancy

They will be on air from mid-June to September 30th 2021 on all bands and modes.

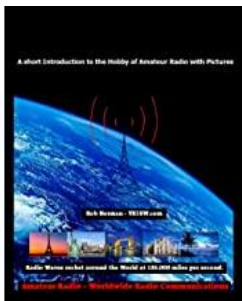

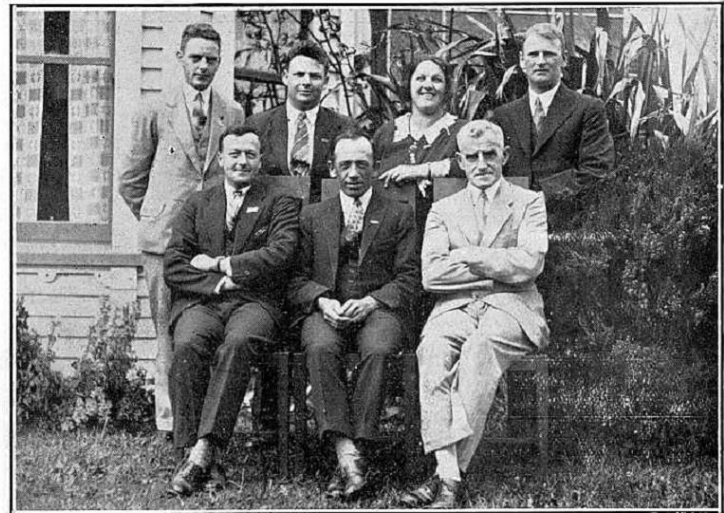

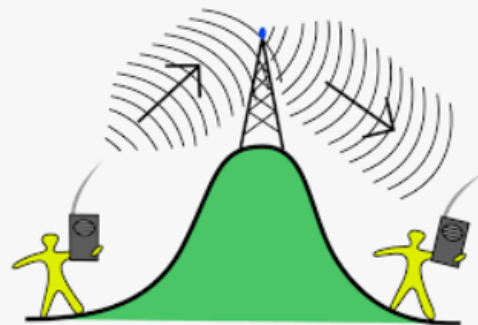
