These updated details should include President and Secretary names and contact details as well as repeater trustees for local and national system repeaters also exam supervisors information as well as club meeting locations and times.

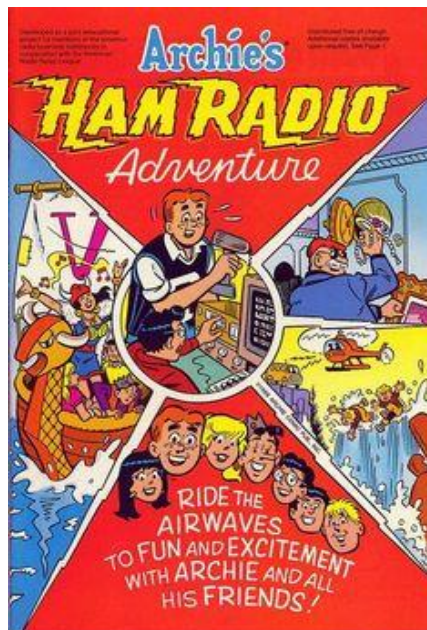

"Early bird" tickets are US\$10 (\$12.50 "at the door"). Access to only the exhibitor area is free.




AREC Regional Manager vacancy
