APRS Repeaters in the South

I am happy to announce I have installed two new APRS repeaters in the South. These where originally transmitting on a special frequency in the EE band for Search and Rescue purposes.

Now they are linked into the 144.575 network. Old Man Range: (ZL4FOX-15) 1.6 km height. 45°21.7408S, 169°12.7698E Blue Mountains: (ZL4FOX-14) 1 km height. 45°53.0492S, 169°23.6202E.

Also a new I-GATE which links both repeaters to APRS-IS: Roxburgh: (ZL4FOX-13) 45°32.2985S, 169°18.7003E.

The Blue Mountains repeater links even directly to the Christchurch repeater, at 380 km distance!
