

3. *Work with RSM to obtain an adjustment to the GuRL to allow the above as an alternate to the existing 50 by 3 requirement. NZART can discuss whether this is instead of or as well as the 50 by 3.*
4. *Work with RSM to investigate whether the GuRL (or other regulatory tool) could also be updated to reflect*
 - a. *The ability for a ham not having achieved competency to be able to work without restrictions provided they are under the direct supervision of a full amateur license holder*
 - b. *The ability for new hams to operate on the 5 – 25 MHz bands (or portions of those bands) with reduced power (say 10 Watts).*
